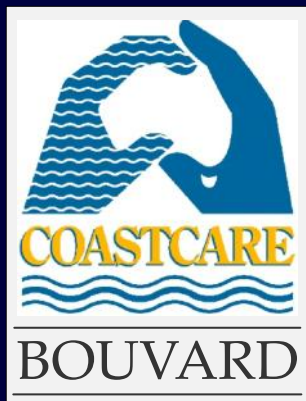

This is an exciting time to be part of Coast Care, if you're already a member, look for our next event, if you're not, **now is the time to join us!**

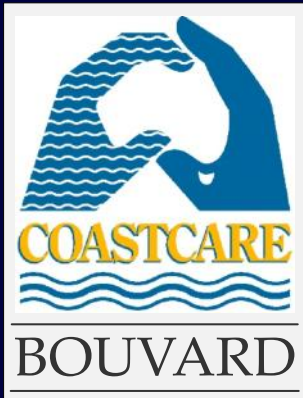

MEAG - what's it all about?

The long-standing Mandurah Environmental Advisory Group (MEAG) has been acknowledged for providing 20 years of invaluable advice to the City of Mandurah but where do Coast Care groups fit in?

The purpose of the Advisory Group is to advise on general **environmental** issues, consistent with the intent of the City's latest Strategic Community Plan. Its objective is to represent the diverse views of the community on **conservation** and **environmental** matters in a democratic manner.

Bouvard Coastcare Group have offered to provide the guest representative for all the local Coast Care Groups and attend regular meetings where issues that affect Mandurah Coast Care Groups are raised and discussed.

Information gained from these meetings is then disseminated to Coast Care members through email & meetings.

As an example, Bouvard Coast Care Group were able to raise the issue of Tim's Thicket Waste Facility and request an update of the current situation to feed back to its members.

Get the app using one of the links above or visit the app store for your phone.

Let a picture paint a thousand words

If you are out walking on the coastal path, using a car park or other facility and see a problem (litter, Trail Bikes on the dunes, broken benches etc), you can report it to the right people quickly & easily using the **Snap Send Solve** app.

Simply take a **photo of the problem** in the app with your phone (which will automatically record the location of the issue & match it to the right local authority) then fill in the comments section & click send.

Your report will be sent direct to the City of Mandurah where it will be recorded & actioned by the right department. If you include your email address, they will even let you know what happens next.
